
Fisher man's Hideaway RVPark

Fisherman's Hideaway RV Park (FHRP) is gate-controlled access provides a secure, home-like atmosphere which offers a variety of activities including topnotch fishing, boating, kayaking (rentals), swimming, and other water sports. The Paradise Landing community area has two large, beautiful, covered pavilions with picnic tables, fire pits, a dock for fishing or sunbathing, and a boat launch. The use of these facilities is open to everyone staying in the Paradise Landing community.

At Fisherman's Hideaway, we're open year-round so you can enjoy riverfront RV living during all four seasons. Each large site offers a full hookup, a combo fire pit/BBQ grill for either wood or charcoal, and a picnic table. One buddy pad is available for those traveling together in two RVs, or for those single RVs who would like more space. The RV pads are compact and level and are topped with small gravel that is comfortable for people and pets to walk on. Speaking of your four-legged friends, let them play and romp in our 15'x60' fenced dog run.

Amenities at the FHRP community area are a large patio area with Adirondack chairs, a fire pit, a hot-water outdoor shower, a large BBQ grill, an 8' picnic table, a sink with hot water, life jackets, and kayaks. You can directly access the river via concrete stairs. This area is designed to provide you with a relaxing area adjacent to the water.

For a little fun, try your hand at a game of horseshoes or corn hole. For the younger kids, a jungle gym with plenty to keep them busy will be available.

ABOVE GROUND POOL



While our pool isn't big enough for pool floats and diving games, there are still plenty of ways to enjoy the water. These games and things to do are perfect for a fun day!

(Buddy Pad)

As you face the river, this is the right half of the 40' x 50' buddy pad. It is a back-in pad. If you're traveling with friends or family, your RV doors will be facing each other for easy communication and sharing of meals. If you're traveling alone, that's not a problem; you can reserve just one pad or reserve the entire pad for yourself. If you want to ensure you don't get a neighbor and want extra space for yourself, there's a slight upcharge. All pads sit up higher on the river, giving a beautiful view of the water and the boats going by.

The pad is level and is topped with gravel. Hookups are 50/30/20amp, city water, septic hookup, motion light near hookups, 46" round picnic table, combo fire pit/grill, and two hose/cord holders.

(Single Pad)

This is a 20' x 50' single pad. It is a pull-in pad. There actually is additional length on the pad to easily accommodate a tow vehicle or boat. To leave the pad, you can drive forward, execute a three-point turn, and drive out or just back out to the street.

All pads sit up higher on the river, giving a beautiful view of the water and the boats going by. The pad is level and is topped with gravel full hookups. Each site also has a motion light at the hookups, a 46" round picnic table, a combo fire pit/grill, and two hose/cord holders. For safety, there is a railing along the edge of the pad with softly lit solar lights topping each post.
